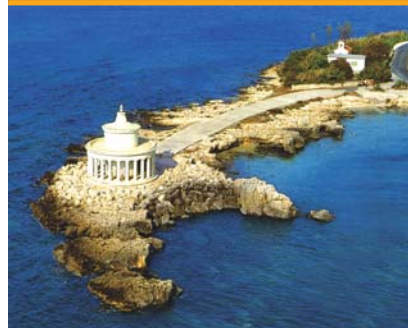

Kefalonia, Greece:

Kefalonia is the largest of the Ionian islands, situated in western Greece. It is a famous tourist resort and one of the most attractive Ionian islands.

The island is largely mountainous, rising to c.5,340 ft (1,630 m) at Mt. Aenos, which in ancient times was crowned by a temple to Zeus. Kefalonia covers an area of 350 sq. miles and is situated between the islands of Zante and Lefkada.
